Admission Policy:

- Ø A variety of teaching and assessment methods are used throughout the course including lectures, workshops, seminar, projects, group discussion, home assignments, quiz, test, with the aim of helping students to equip themselves with practical skills and competency.

FACULTY

OUR LIBRARY

The library functions as the heart of the college. Our library has an excellent collection of 19251 volumes with adequate coverage of all subjects thought. Books may be borrowed for home-reading and also for the reference in the library reading room. Leaving journals and magazines are available. Shri. S. Y. Miraji Trust poor student's lending library is helping the poor and deserving students. Library is well equipped with internet facility and fully computerized.

The library is kept open 10:00 a.m to 5:00 p.m during all working days and 8.00 a. m to 5.00 p. m during University Examination.

GYMKHANA AND SPORTS

The Gymkhana department of the college provides the best facilities in the field of sports and games. The college has 200 mtrs track and necessary infrastructure facility for athletics/Sports events, like volley ball, Kabaddi, Kho-Kho, Cricket, Hand Ball, Floor Ball, Net Ball, Tenni koit etc., Gymkhana Provides, Table Tennis, Chess, Carom. The department is looked after by the highly qualified and experienced Physical Education Director.

Computer Laboratory: Our computer laboratory is one of the unique features of the college. It houses 100 computers. The machines are connected with an NT server. The computer laboratory is well equipped with internet facility. The practical's for B. Com Classes and training computers for arts students are conducted in the computer lab.

Language Lab: we have established Language Lab of 20 students for the improvement of English language of our students.

Ladies Room: Recently renovated ladies room caters to all requirements of the ladies students besides providing privacy and security.

Women's Hostel: Women's hostel is constructed under UGC grant Xth and XIth Plan with all modern amenities which can accommodate 60 students. The details of Hostel admission procedure may be obtained from the office of the hostel warden.

Student Support Service:

College Union: Our college union consists various associations like, cultural, literacy, Social Science, commerce and ladies association. It conducts various Extra-Curricular activities like debating extempore, quiz, essay, general knowledge, singing competition and like. These competition are arranged to inculcate the spirit of competition and to keep abreast the latest development in different branches of knowledge.

NCC: The college NCC has one unit of 104 cadets to train all above bodied and willing male and female students in the art of defense to mould their character and personality. The training is given to the cadets by the experienced NCC officers. Our students have represented the college in the RD Parade at New Delhi. NCC cadets should attend 90% of the parades conducted during the year.

NSS: The college NSS unit enrolls 100 volunteers to train them in selfless services to the institution and the society. NSS camp is organized every year in adopted village. The NSS volunteers shall attend a minimum of 120 service hours during the year.

Career Guidance and Placement Cell: A question before many students is what next? As a solution to such questions earnest efforts are made by offering employment guidance to students of the college sourcing Placement an added feature. The objective is to lead students on the path of success with renewed vigor and confidence.

Student Welfare: The college takes every step to make the students stay in the campus both joyful and memorable one. In that direction we take care of students grievances redressal cell is established specifically for this purpose.  4. Students are required to bring their identity cards and hall tickets at the time of all examinations.
 5. If the student loses his/her identity cards he/she has to apply for the issue of duplicate identity card by paying a fee of Rs. 40 and explaining the circumstances of loss of identity cards.
 6. Every student is required to keep a minimum of 75% attendance in both theory and practicals in all subjects. The students who fail to keep the required attendance are not allowed to fill examination form.
 7. The students are required to attend all tests, seminars, practicals and theory examinations to be conducted by the college. The students who remain absent without valid reasons will be liable for fine and disciplinary action.
 8. All Applications for fee concessions, scholarships, fresher's, etc, should be submitted with necessary documents before the last date fixed. Late applications are not accepted.
 9. Recommendation for the award of fee concession scholarships etc will be on the basis of regular attendance and satisfactory progress of students. The scholarships, fee concessions and freships etc sanctioned will be refunded to government if the attendance & progress of the students is not satisfactory.
 10. All Extra-Curricular activities such as debates, singing, essay competitions are conducted by college union which consists of various associations like cultural association, literary association, social science, commerce and ladies association.

8. Students are forbidden to write or make any marks on the walls and boards in the college or on the desk or any piece of furniture.
